Collection of the following items:


- Books for the Shady Grove Book Swap Shelf (Shady Grove only)

- *Government equipment only without NIH decals or barcodes please.
- Computer-Related Paraphernalia: computer-keyboards, mice, cables, speakers, web cams, CDs, floppy disks, etc. (basically, anything that will plug in and uses electricity).
- Small Appliances: small clean microwaves, coffee makers, toasters, etc.
- Nothing too large or heavy. NO BROKEN GLASS and NOTHING SHARP OR POINTY.
- Also consult with your Property Custodial Officer (PCO) or <u>Property</u> <u>Accountability Officer (PAO)</u>.
