Guidance on Government Non-Accountable Electronics and New/Unopened Office Supplies

- *Government equipment only without NIH decals or barcodes please.
- Computer-Related Paraphernalia: computer-keyboards, mice, cables, speakers, web cams, CDs, floppy disks, etc. (basically, anything that will plug in and uses electricity).
- Small Appliances: small clean microwaves, coffee makers, toasters, etc.
- Nothing too large or heavy. NO BROKEN GLASS and NOTHING SHARP OR POINTY.
- Office Supplies: Only new/unopened office supplies — from Self Service Stores or purchased with a P Card.
- Also consult with your Property Custodial Officer (PCO) or Property Accountability Officer (PAO).
